Locally Sourced, Hand-Crafted Wares Return to the Arts Council for Holiday Marketplace!

Lake Oswego, Oregon – Holiday Marketplace returns this November and December - making it convenient for the community to shop for those hard-to-find gifts in a safe and comfortable shopping environment - while supporting local makers and artists. The exhibition runs from November 16 through December 24 at the ARTspace Gallery located at 380 A Avenue, Suite A, Lake Oswego.

In its fifth year, the hand-selected, all-media Holiday Marketplace will showcase work including fine art, wood, ceramics, jewelry, handmade gifts, ornaments, cards, textiles, accessories, soaps and candles, along with hand-crafted confections, and much more!

This curated collection of work includes Ha Austin - ceramics, Madsass Soap – homemade soaps, bath salts, and lotions, Reclaimed Wool – ornaments and home goods, Sora Shodo – fine art, along with beloved pieces from Emily Miller – ceramics, cards, and watrcolor, Tiger Food Press – home goods, prints, and cards, LeBrie Rich – felt ornaments, cards, and kits, Stubborn Stiles – jewelry and iconic ornaments, wood crafters like Gary Blumanthal and Dennis Curtis, Rosey Covert with her basketry art, and the Candy RX – scrumptious candy confections, just to name a few.
